



Depending on availability of funds, Applied Anthropology Graduate Students can receive funding to reimburse travel, lodging, membership, and registration expenses for professional conferences at which they are presenting papers or posters. Masters students are eligible for up to \$500 while pursuing their degree. PhD students are eligible for up to \$1000 while pursuing their degree.

To process your request, please submit the following *at least two weeks prior* to conference travel:

1. This form *with your major professor's signature*
2. Proof of your conference presentation (e.g., a copy of an acceptance Email from the conference organizer or a preliminary program page with your name/title/abstract)
3. Budget including line items for travel (flight and/or ground transport), lodging, membership, registration (general registration and/or any workshops or other relevant activities), subtotals, any funding that is already available, and the total amount requested from the Applied Anthropology Graduate Program.

Requests cannot be processed until you have your major professor's signature and notification of acceptance of your abstract by the meeting organizers.
