

# PCC TO OSU 2+2 TRANSFER PLAN

## Psychology Hybrid B.S. with AAOT in Portland

Oregon State University College of Liberal Arts

Total required credits: 180 needed for B.S.

Upper-division credits: 60 credits of 300- or 400-level coursework MUST come from OSU to graduate with a B.S.

B.S. requirements fulfilled by: CIS 120, BI 101, MTH 243, PSY 298 and either MTH 105 or MTH 111.

Note: B.A. requires 2 years of a language (or equivalent proficiency); see 2+2 Transfer Plan for Psychology B.A. for details.
