

CCC TO OSU 2+2 TRANSFER PLAN

Psychology Hybrid B.A. with AAOT in Portland

Oregon State University College of Liberal Arts

Total required credits: 180 needed for B.A.

Upper-division credits: 60 credits of 300- or 400-level coursework MUST come from OSU to graduate with a B.A.

Note: B.S. requires an additional science course and a computer science course; see 2+2 Transfer Plan for Psychology B.S. for details.

B.A. requires 2nd year proficiency in a second language:

- Take placement exam online to demonstrate 2nd year or higher proficiency. (Most heritage speakers test into the 3rd year.) Students who test 2nd year or higher have 24 elective credits that can be used for a minor, internship credit, or second major.
- Or take 2 full years/6 quarters of the same language with C- or higher in the last term. At CCC, language courses are generally numbered 101, 102, 103, 201, 202, 203.
