

Does your content belong on the website?

In 2021, the CLA websites included over 5,000 pages of content (too many). More than half of that content was out-of-date, duplicative, or belonged on another site/platform. This made for confusion and frustration not only by our primary audience (students) but by search engines like Google, who penalize sites for old/duplicative content.

Content that belongs on the website (and content that doesn't)

Belongs

- College Information
- School/Program information
- Learning Outcomes
- Degree Tracks/Requirements
- Student Advising
- Student Resources
- News/Events from the past 4 years

Doesn't Belong

- Individual class information/resources
- Faculty CV information outside of their Drupal faculty profile page
- News/Events over 4 years old
- Duplicative content
- Meeting Minutes
- Archives
- Any information that isn't backed-up offline
