Join a community of bilinguals and multilinguals. Study Spanish. Discuss complex cultural ideas and travel abroad to expand your world. Distinguish yourself as a competitive candidate for national prestigious scholarships and careers in translation, interpretation, business, government, education, diplomacy, law, science, and much more.

Currently, the Spanish Program has 13 full-time faculty members, over 500 undergraduate majors and minors, and a rapidly growing cohort of on-line Spanish majors (E-campus) . We offer a wide variety of courses in the following topics: grammar, culture, Spanish for medical professions, literature, Spanish for business, cultures of Spain and Portugal, Cultures of Latin America, and Spanish for Heritage/Native speakers

Your Bachelor's Degree (BA) in the College of Liberal Arts



- A minimum of 180 credits are required for graduation; 60 must be upper division (300 and 400-level courses).
- A maximum of 124 credits earned at a community college may be applied toward a bachelor's degree at OSU.
- Only courses with letter prefixes and numbers above 100 can be accepted.
- Some courses can count towards your major and the Baccalaureate Core. Check with your advisor.
- Options available. See "Important Notes".

Important Notes for the College and Major:

- Grade requirements can vary; refer to your OSU advisor.

- Other similar majors to explore: French, German, English
- First and second year Spanish and some Baccalaureate Core are priority courses to complete before transferring to OSU.
- Talk with an OSU advisor about your specific timeline for the best time to transfer.
- It is important to speak with your OSU advisor early on, and often, to ensure correct course selection and sequencing.

Resources and OSU Information:

- Students do not have to complete a transfer degree in order to transfer to OSU.
 - If you've completed the Oregon AAOT, all requirements of the Baccalaureate Core are complete except for Synthesis Courses and Writing Intensive Courses.

BA Requirement: Second-year proficiency in a second language (including ASL) at the college level with at least a C-. When majoring in a foreign language, your BA requirement can be fulfilled by your major language courses.
