#### **NW Climate Adaptation center Graduate Fellows; call for proposals**

OSU is now a partner in the USGS-sponsored NW Climate Adaptation Science Center, housed at the University of Washington. Because of a delay in getting our partnership approved, we missed the initial call for proposals for the 2019-20 Climate Fellows Program, and this year's cohort was already announced. However, our new partners would really like to see some OSU students in this year's cohort, so we have a short window of opportunity for our students and their mentors to submit proposals. Proposals are due November 25, with announcement of fellows by mid-December- please see attached for complete information.

The NW CASC Research Fellowship Program<sub>1</sub> aims to support the development of science relevant to natural and cultural resource managers facing climate-related risks and challenges. To achieve this aim, the program supports research involving graduate students and postdoctoral scientists and provides instruction in the principles and practices of coproduction of decision-relevant ("actionable") science.

Research should also be relevant to at least one **NW CASC science priority areas** detailed in the NW CASC Science Agenda for 2018-2023<sub>2</sub>:

- Managing aquatic resources
- Managing at-risk species and habitats
- Managing invasives and diseases
- Managing forest ecosystems
- Managing shrubland ecosystems
- Managing working lands and waters
- Incorporating human dimensions of climate adaptation

Priority will be given to projects that demonstrably leverage other efforts and resources (e.g., tuition cost-share or funding from other governmental and private organizations) and for which NW CASC funding will make a demonstrable difference. Start date, duration, and funding level of individual awards are negotiable based on the project timeline, needs of the prospective fellow and funding available from other sources. Previous awards have averaged around \$30,000, with a range of \$8,000 to \$65,000. A budget template is available at: https://nwcasc.uw.edu/resources/funding-opportunities/.

The City of Eugene Finance Division Budget and Analysis team is looking for a driven and inquisitive intern to join us in an organizational growth project. Internship duties may include, but are not limited to, researching local government best practices, analyzing results, conducting interviews with organizational stakeholders, reporting research findings, and assisting in developing strategic recommendations for City of Eugene leadership.

This role requires a high level of self-directed professionalism, attention to detail, and flexibility as goals and tasks may shift throughout the duration of the internship. Successful candidates must be able to demonstrate excellent writing skills, familiarity with basic research methodology, interest in learning about local government processes, and dedication to a successful professional internship experience. Priority may be given to applicants who will incorporate this research into a thesis project and/or combine this with departmental internship credits, depending on the applicant pool. Environmental decisions include trade-offs. Advanced policy choices for sustainably providing Earth's 7.7 billion people with food, energy, and water are urgently needed. Considered in isolation, these sectors generate risk outcomes that impose long-term costs and potential catastrophic climate burdens. This transdisciplinary course examines emerging integrated policies concerning sustainable provision of food, energy, and water and their relationship to climate.

# THE IMPACT OF RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA SALES LEGALIZATION ON WORKPLACE INJURIES: EVIDENCE FROM OREGON

Recreational marijuana will soon be available to nearly 1 in 4 Americans under state statutes. This paper estimates the impact of the recreational marijuana sales legalization (RML) on workplace injuries. Using restricted-use Workers' Compensation claims as a proxy for injuries, I exploit variation in the county level implementation of recreational marijuana law in Oregon. Local governments could implement bans if less than 45% voters in their jurisdiction voted in favor of RML. In order to identify the casual impact of RML, I first utilize Difference-in-Difference strategy to compare the injury rate before and after RML for high exposure counties to the same difference for low exposure counties. To relax the parallel trends assumption, I use a data-driven procedure, known as the Synthetic Control Method to construct suitable comparison groups. Lastly, I exploit variation in the vote share rule near the cutoff under a Regression Discontinuity Design. My estimates suggest workplace injury rate is approximately 5%-20% higher for treated relative to control counties post-RML. It also indicates that RML increases work injury costs roughly by \$7 to \$34 million (or \$5 to \$24 per capita) per year. Overall, my results imply that recreational marijuana sales legalization may come at the expense of workplace injury.
