

New Media Communications

Minor Requirements Worksheet

The New Media Communications (NMC) minor curriculum is a minimum of 27 credits, 15 of which must be at the upper-division level. A minimum grade of C- is required for all NMC minor courses. **Please see the online catalog for current course offerings.**

An NMC minor allows students from all disciplines to complement their chosen field of study with an understanding of mediated communications from a new media perspective. Students will better understand how to process the information they receive about their chosen field, and how to effectively distribute information about their own work in our society. Topics include social media strategy, sound design, media management, film production, media theory, animation, and more.
