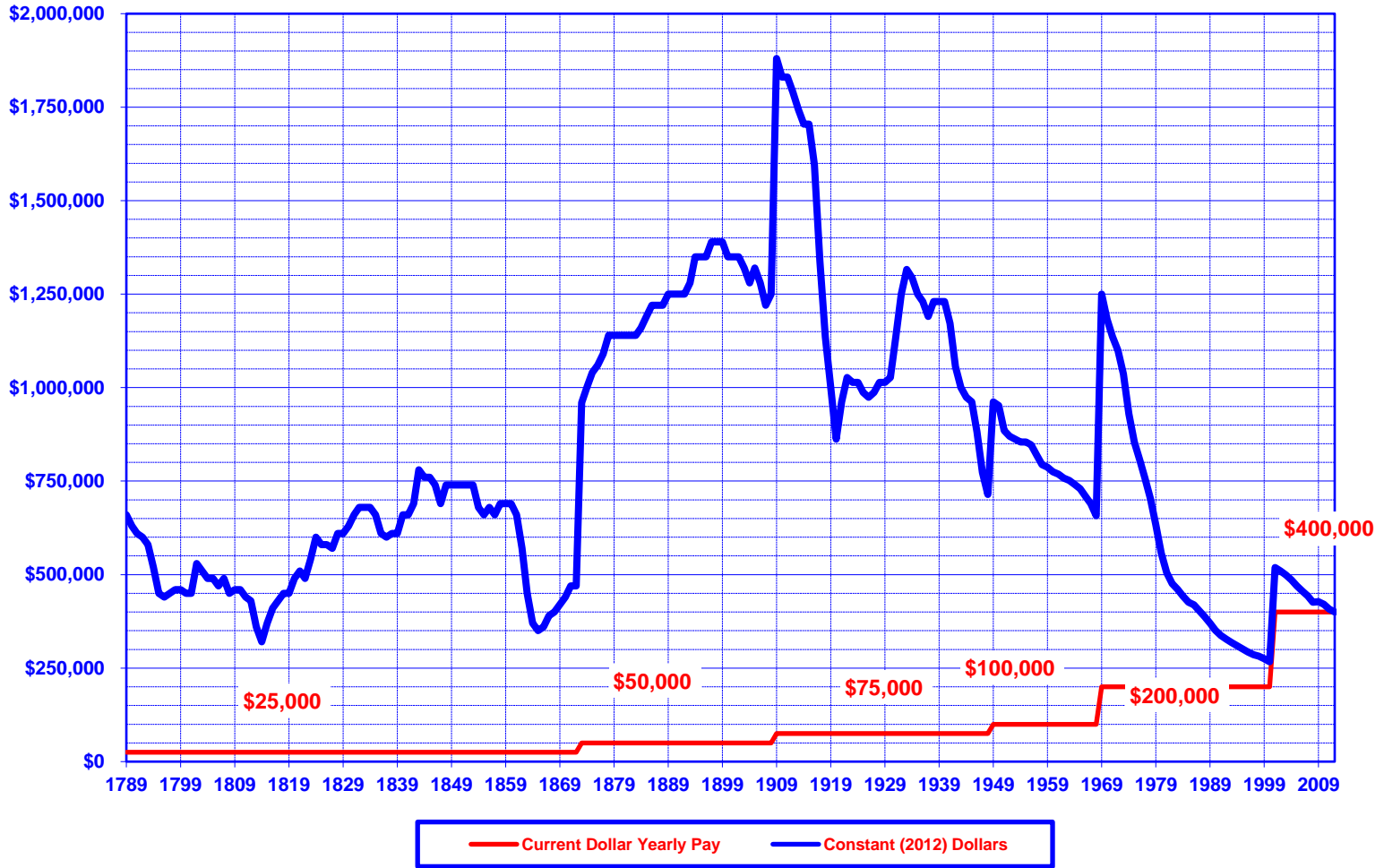


Presidential Pay 1789 to 2012, in Current and Constant (2012) dollars

Data prior to 1913 should be considered approximations. Starting in 1949 presidents also have had a \$50,000 per year expense account, worth about \$460,000 that year in 2010 dollars.
