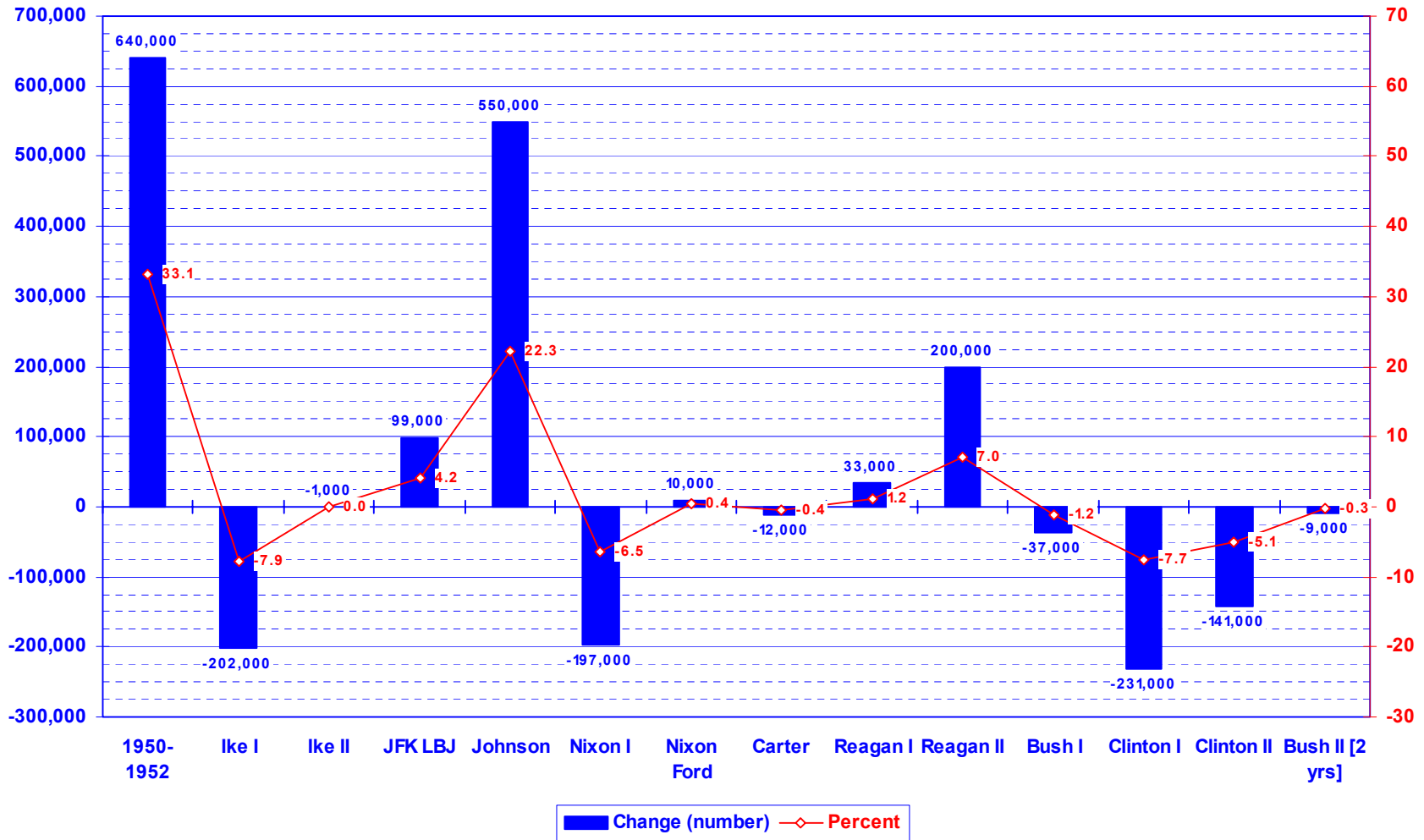
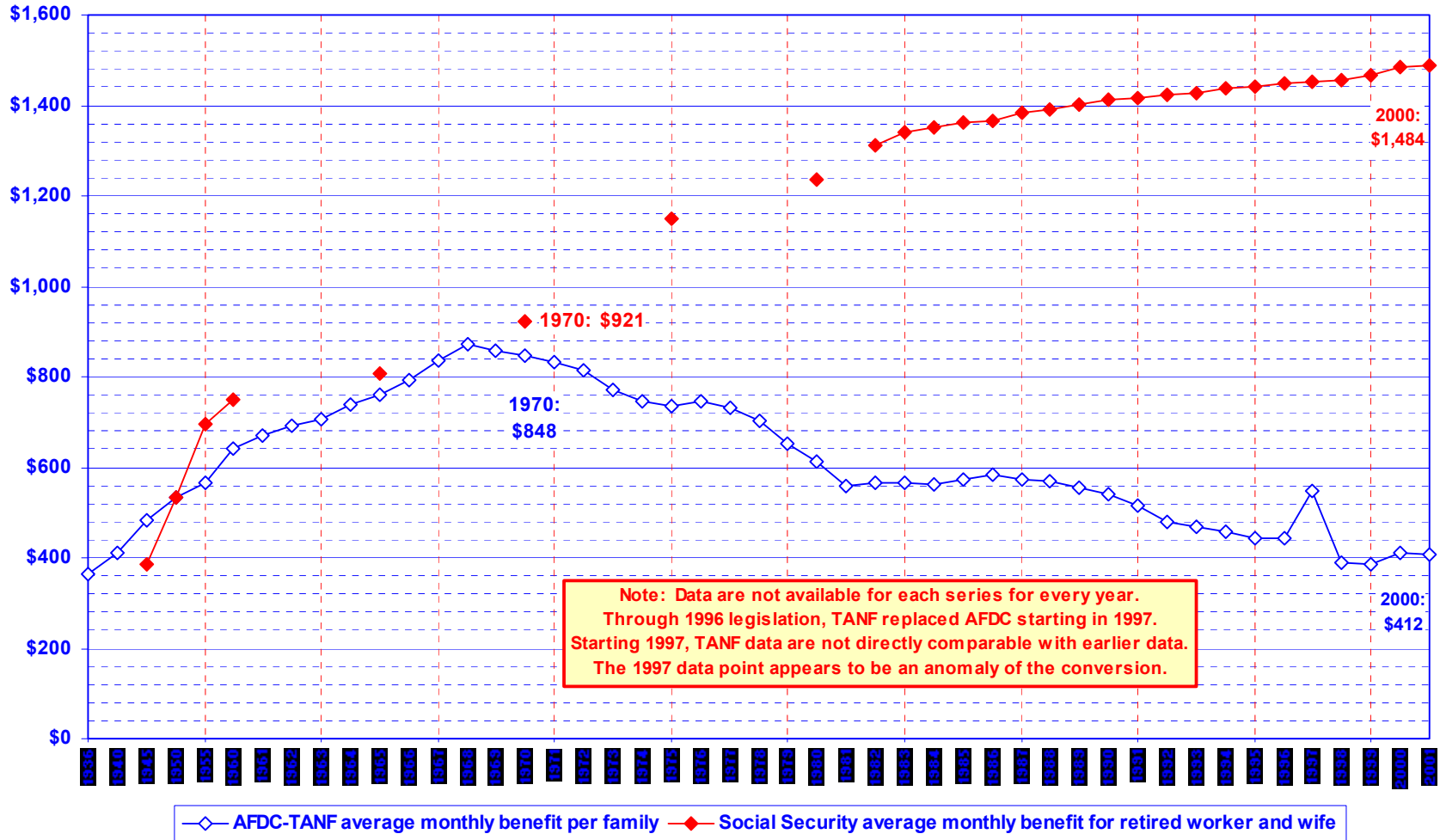

### Change in National Government Executive Branch Employment by Presidential Term, 1950 to 2002, in Numbers and Percent

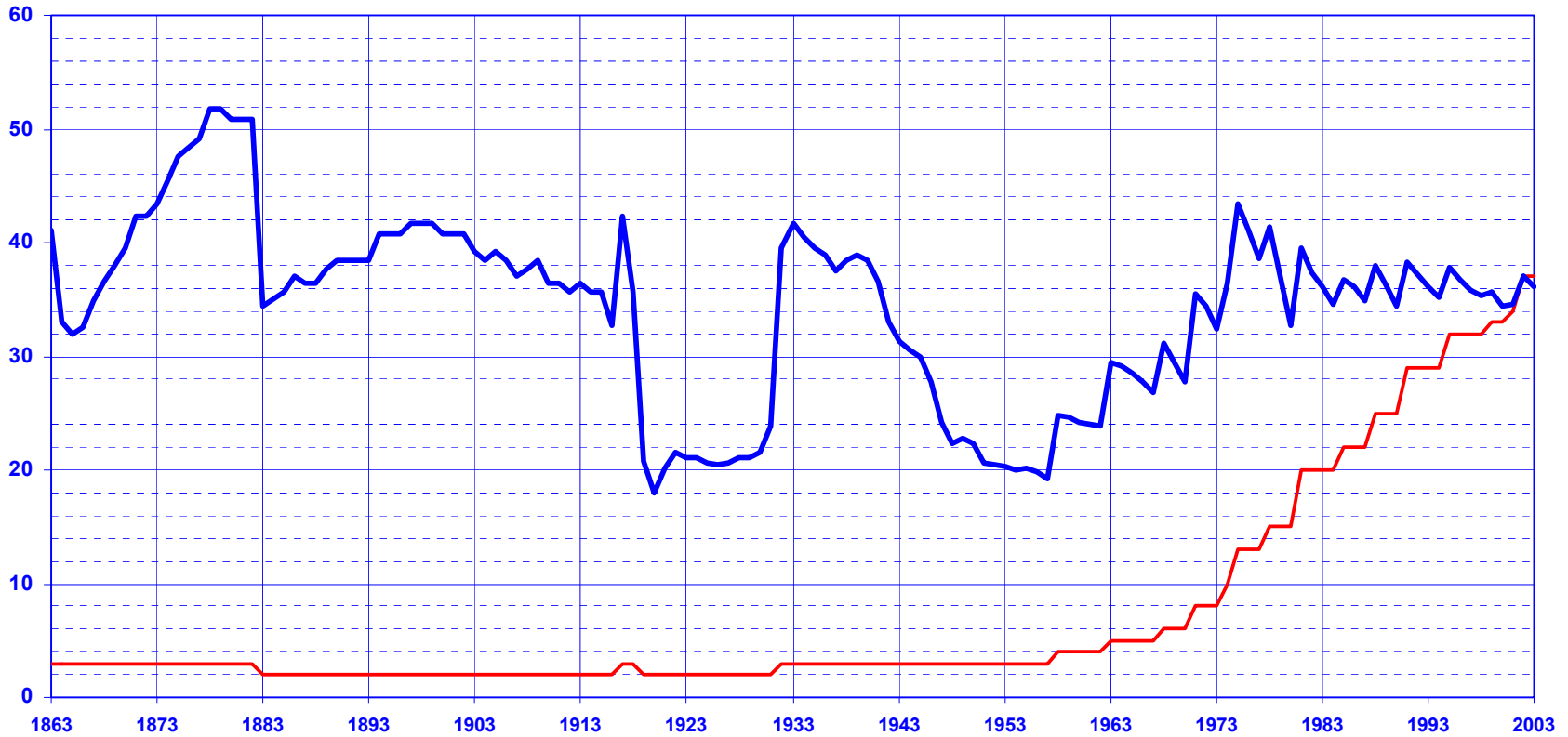

### US First Class Postage Rates in Current and Constant (2002) Cents for First Ounce, 1863 to 2003



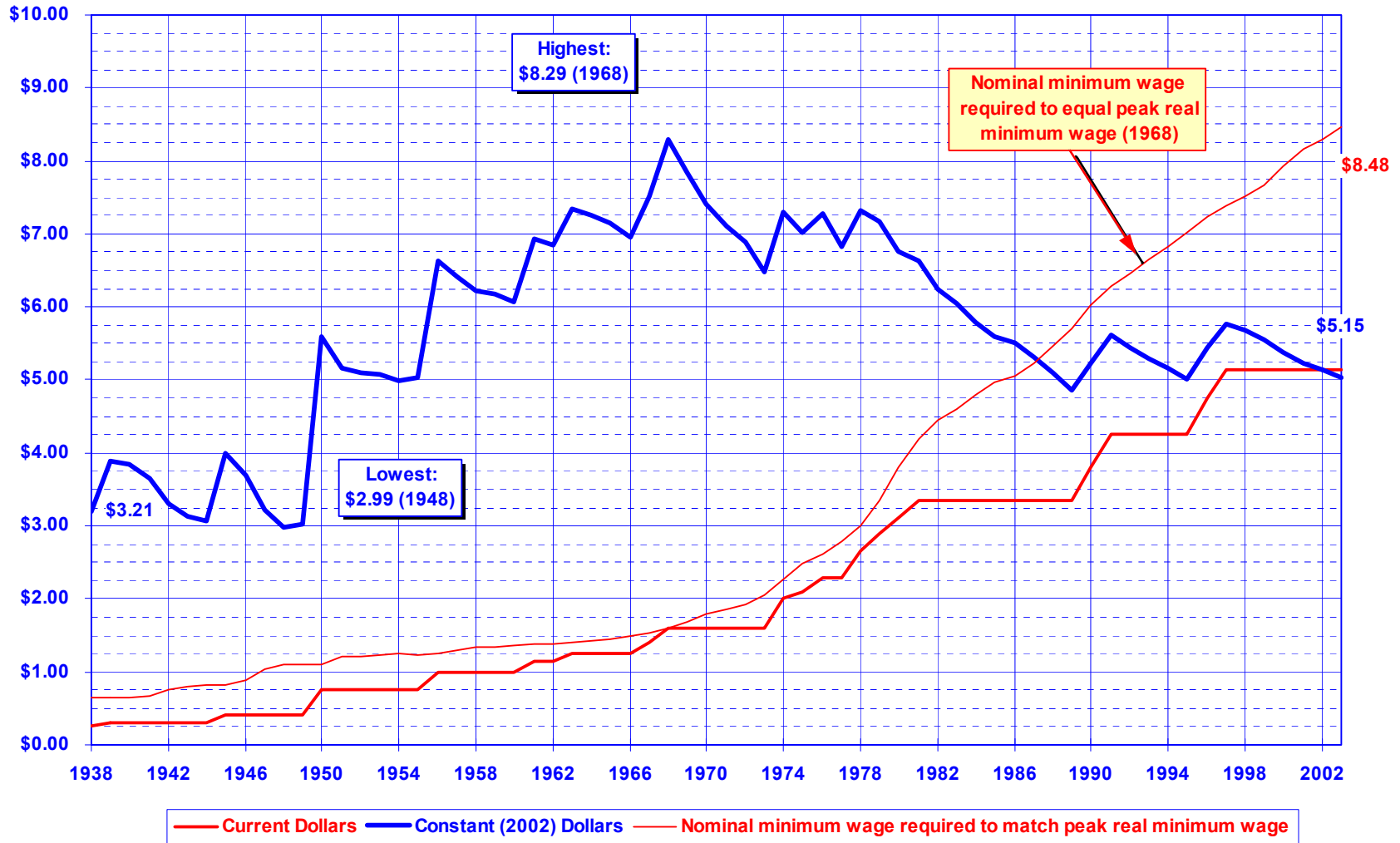
Until 1845, postage was based on number of sheets in a letter and distance traveling. From 1845 until 1863, postage was based on weight and distance. From 1863 to 1885, price was for the first half ounce.

Beginning 1975, price for each additional ounce is less than for the first ounce.

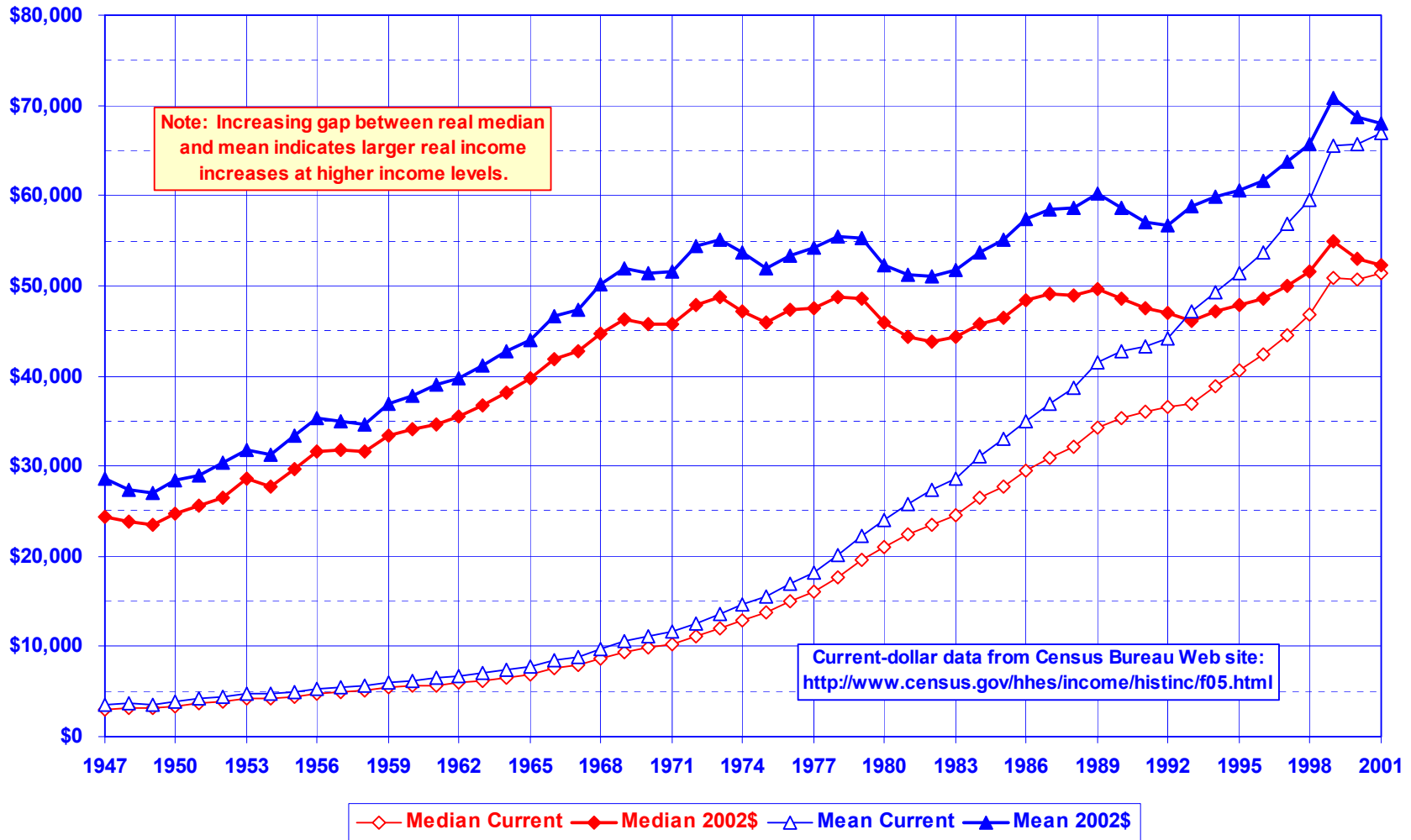

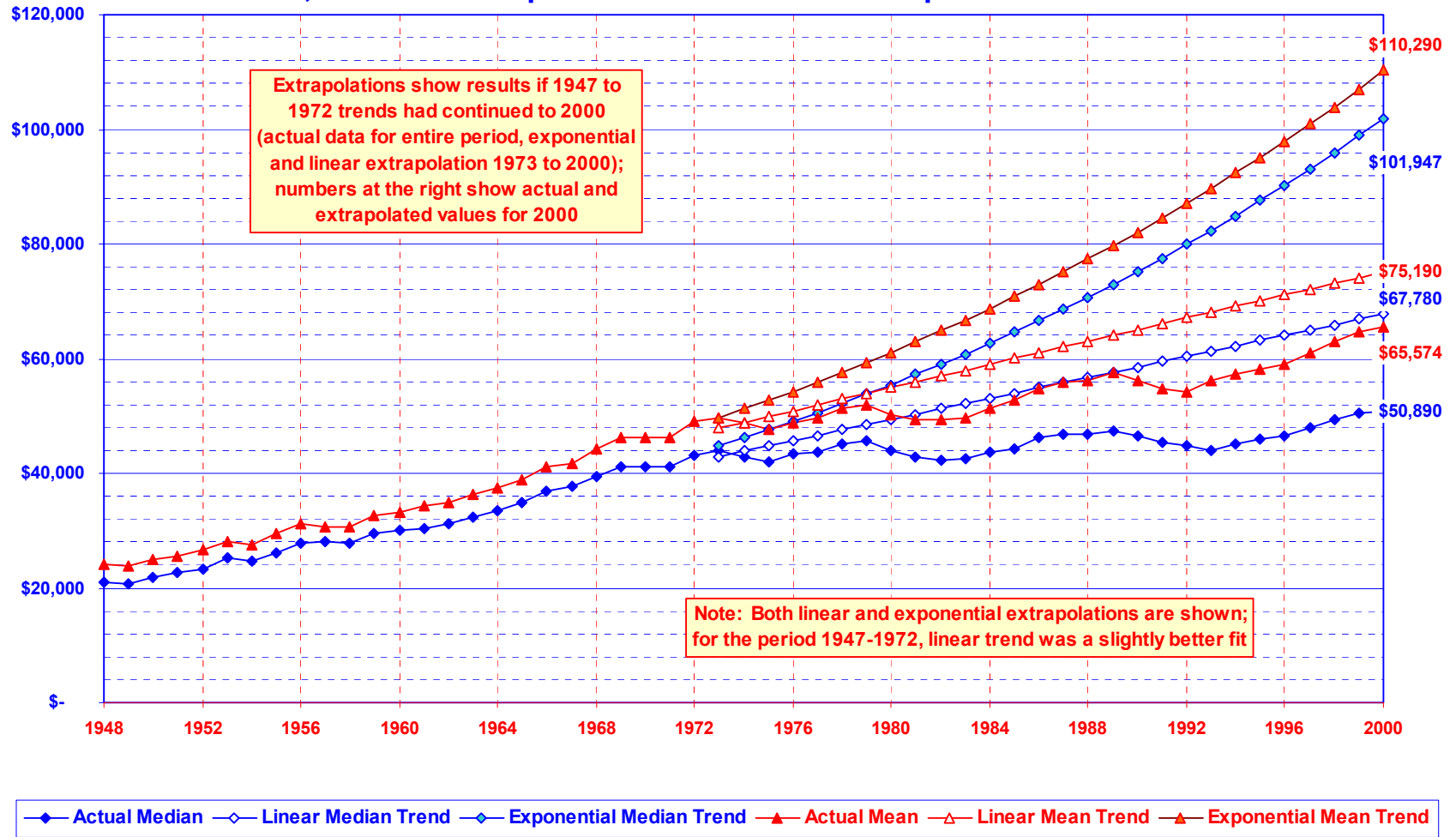
### Minimum Wage in Current and Constant (2002) Dollars, 1938 through 2003
